- CAF /UEFA A Football Coaching license a must
- Must have good experience of coaching women's football at either club or a National team level for at least 3 years with traceable performance record;
- Have the ability to scout players for the development pathway and develop the talent to elite level of performance;
- Have practical sound knowledge of preparing realistic a workable talent identification programme and implementing within available resources;
- Have great capacity for adaptation and ability to work with players and provide guidance for the career;
- Have a knowledge of computer tools and be able to keep database of the women football players;
- Be able to instill high discipline in the players
- Ability to work in the multi-cultural team environment and deliver results within tight deadlines
- Knowledge of Malawi football is a must.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills, fluent in English.
- Proven knowledge and expertise in football regulations.
- Track record of successful delivery of high-quality reports and advice to Football Associations
- Track record of grooming Women's Football Coaches
- Leadership, communication and networking skills
- Experience in governance and development of accountability frameworks
- Track record of successful delivery of high-quality reports and advice for women's football development

- Excellent communication and relationship-building skills.

Responsibilities

- To train and coach the Women's National Football Team;
- Lead in the selection process of players for the Women National Team and submit the names of the players to be called for camp training to FAM through the office of the Technical Director ;
- Plan and prepare training programs as and when the Women's National Football Team has engagements and submit to the Technical Director for further action;
- Oversee all camping and training aspects of the Women's National Team and manage the lead the technical staff;
- Improve the level of performance of the individual players and the team technically, tactically, mentally, physically and psychologically;
- Prepare the technical report on games played by Malawi Women's National Team and submit to the General Secretary of FAM through the office of the Technical Director within 7 days after the game;
- Come up with a clear program on all technical issues pertaining to Women's game
- Come up with clear training program of Women's Football Coaches
- Develop and implement a clear grassroot program for Women's Football in consultation with Technical Sub Committee and National Women's Football Association
- Any other duties assigned from time to time.
